

Any sovereign state is entitled to implement appropriate measures to prevent people from illegally entering their countries, and this right becomes immeasurably stronger when that country is faced with a constant threat of terrorist infiltration.

Israelis – particularly those young soldiers who have to man them – also hate the checkpoint system, which exposes them to the hatred of the people they are required to control as well as the constant danger of terrorist attacks.

By abandoning the peace process and resorting to methods of indiscriminate violence against the Israeli people, the Palestinians themselves have created the checkpoints about which they so strenuously complain.
